

**BLUE MAN GROUP TO RELEASE FIRST-EVER CONCERT
DVD 'THE COMPLEX ROCK TOUR LIVE'**

NOVEMBER 25 ON LAVA RECORDS

BLUE MAN GROUP will release their first-ever rock concert DVD, THE COMPLEX ROCK TOUR LIVE, November 25 on Lava Records. THE COMPLEX ROCK TOUR LIVE encompasses live concert footage, music videos, and select songs from the group's album, THE COMPLEX, in 5.1 Surround Sound. The live concert footage on the DVD was filmed during the group's successful and widely acclaimed rock tour before 9,000 fans over two sold-out concerts August 12 and 13 at NextStage Amphitheatre in Grand Prairie, Texas. BLUE MAN GROUP thrilled audiences across North America with The Complex Rock Tour which visited over 70 cities on a cross country trek during the summer and fall of 2003. The Complex Rock Tour has recruited thousands of new Blue Man fans.

THE COMPLEX ROCK TOUR LIVE DVD was filmed with five cameras to capture the over-the-top audio/visual celebration of the BLUE MAN GROUP rock show. In addition to concert footage, the THE COMPLEX ROCK TOUR LIVE DVD includes music videos for "Sing Along" (featuring guest vocalist Dave Matthews), "The Current" (with guest vocalist Gavin Rossdale) and "Exhibit 13," BLUE MAN GROUP's stirring video tribute to the events of September 11. As an added bonus, the flip side of the DVD is comprised of 5.1 Surround Sound mixes of three songs from THE COMPLEX: "Above," "Your Attention" and "Sing Along."

The Chicago Sun-Times described The Complex Rock Tour as "Awesome musicianship enhanced by unadulterated good humor and fun," and went on to pose the question, "What more could you ask for in a rock 'n' roll concert?" Dave Ferman in his *Fort Worth Star-Telegram* review of the August 12 show wrote, "For all its conceptual smarts, though, this show is exhilarating because at its heart is a love for the music and for people coming together to celebrate their love of music." *The Contra Costa Times* called the rock show, "One of the best pure entertainment spectacles ever conceived." And *The Pittsburgh Post-Gazette* simply referred to The Complex Rock Tour as "A world class rock'n'roll concert."
